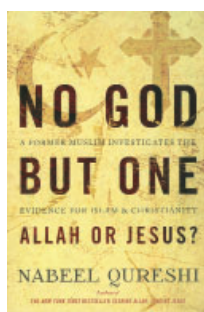

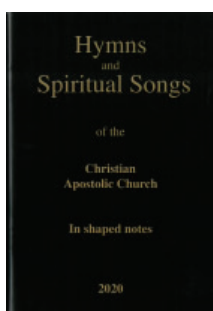
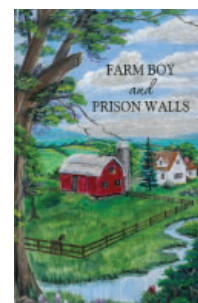


## No God But One
